This is a Version Change Summary for win.COMPARE² software that identifies the specific modifications made from the previous version of win.COMPARE² to the upgraded version. The matrix on the following page lists each specific area that is changed in the software program (*Area Affected*); a description of what was changed, updated, added, corrected, modified, etc. and in some cases why (*Description*); and if there is (or is not) an impact on the CCF and/or CCF documentation (*CCF/Documentation Impact*). This last area is critical to determine if a CCF needs to be recomputed. Notes for Version 1.5A:

1. To obtain the latest version of win.COMPARE², please go to <http://compare.mevatec.com> and select the **DOWNLOAD** option in the menu bar on the left hand side of the website. If further assistance is needed for downloading the files, refer to the **Download Instructions** link on the Download page. If a previous version of win.COMPARE² is currently installed and functioning properly on your system, you only need to download the COMPARE.MDE file and copy and paste it into the folder where win.COMPARE² is installed on your computer (default is C:\WINCOMPARE).
2. **IMPORTANT:** When opening old files in the latest version of win.COMPARE², click on the **GLOBAL UPDATE** button. This will update the costs in the win.COMPARE² file to reflect changes made to the program.
3. No changes were made to the tables in Version 1.5A.
4. No changes were made to the User's Manual.
5. No changes were made to the help files in Version 1.5A.

#	Area Affected	Description	CCF/Documentation Impact
1	Line 3A (Capital Assets)	<p>Corrected a problem where the cost in the last performance period is deleted (set to zero) for asset records where the useful life was extended. This occurs only for certain performance period/acquisition date combinations.</p> <p>If a users cost comparison file contains capital asset records where the useful life was extended, and the file was opened and updated in Version 1.5, then it is possible that the user will need to recheck those specific records to determine if the costs are included in the appropriate extended performance periods.</p>	CCF and documentation will be impacted if the win.COMPARE ² file contains these type asset records and the file was opened in Version 1.5.
